

Clean Water Advisory Committee Updates

(August 25, 2022) The Wyoming Valley Sanitary Authority's (WVSA) Stormwater Management Division, in partnership with the Pennsylvania Environmental Council (PEC), recently welcomed 18 local applicants to the inaugural Clean Water Advisory Committee (CWAC). The CWAC is comprised of citizens from eight WVSA service area municipalities, including representatives from regional businesses, educational institutions, community nonprofit organizations and governmental agencies.

The CWAC is a localized, collaborative group focusing on stormwater management programs that may lend further support to WVSA's Regional Stormwater Management Program. To date, CWAC meetings were held in April, May and July of this year.

The CWAC anticipates re-evaluating its membership as it progresses. In the interim, public events are in the planning stages, including a free public Rain Barrel Workshop scheduled for 10 a.m. Saturday, September 24, at Kirby Park in Wilkes-Barre. This WVSA event will also be hosted by members of the Penn State Master Watershed Steward Program.
