On behalf of the Wyoming Valley Sanitary Authority (WVSA), I thank you for supporting the recent Growing Greener Watershed Protection Grants awarded to us for implementation of the Warrior Creek and Gardner Creek stream restoration projects. These green infrastructure projects are required to be implemented as part of our regionalized Pollutant Reduction Plan (PRP) and help us comply with the state's Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) regulations.

The proposed stream restoration projects will have a direct impact on improving both stream and overall watershed quality by removing pollutants, including sediment and nutrients (nitrogen and phosphorus) from our waterways. With the implementation of these stream restoration projects, we will restore more than 6,000 feet of streams located in our communities.
